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2. Manuscripts for publication should be sent by means of electronic mail to:

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3. All text (Portuguese or English or Spanish) should be, Times New Roman 12-point font, double spaced, with a maximum length of 30 pages (10.000/12.000 words), including charts, tables, maps, notes (body 10). The article is preceded by the following information: the title, the author's name, the institutional affiliation and the email address. This information should be followed by a brief abstract in English (maximum 150 words) where the purpose of the research, the main results, and the major conclusions of the study should be stated, and a series of 5 keywords.

4. All graphics, pictures, images and maps must be inserted in the main text, accompanied by a title and a reference to the source of origin. For each manuscript, all this graphical information should be supplied in separated files clearly identified with those inserted on the text and in a universal format. The figures must be attached by a separate file in JPG format with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. The size of a figure should allow one to see it in detail (minimum size is 9.0 × 12.0 cm, maximum size is 12.0 × 22.5)

5. Citing and Referencing (Harvard System).

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The original sources of information should be referred along the text by the “Harvard System” (author-date, plus page numbers, if it is the case of direct citations). Examples: (Kotler and Rainisto, 2002) or (Kotler and Rainisto, 2002, p. 26)
